Barclays Community Account offers free everyday banking to not-for-profit organisations with a charitable purpose and an annual turnover of less than £100,000. If your organisation fits this criteria, please continue to complete this eligibility check.

To start your application, you must be able to answer yes to at least one of the statements below. Please go through the statements in order. The first statement to which you can say yes defines your reference number.

If you are unable to answer yes to any of the statements, unfortunately, your organisation does not meet the eligibility criteria for this account.
