

## How to register for Online Banking

Barclays Online Banking is a secure way to access your accounts 24 hours a day.

With Online Banking, you can

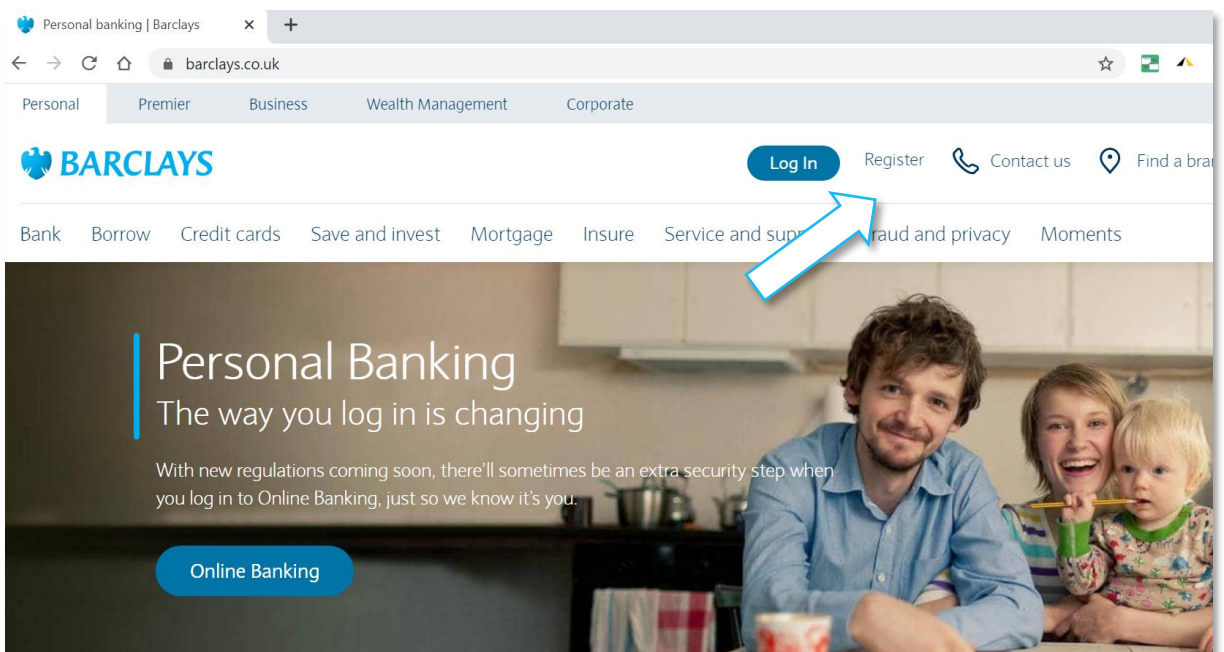
- Check balances, transfer money and pay bills
- View and download statements
- Manage Direct Debits and standing orders
- View your debit card PIN
- Report a lost or stolen card

To get started, you'll need

- To live in the UK
- Be 16 or older
- A Barclays current or savings account with a bank card, or a Barclays mortgage
- Your Barclays account details
- A computer with an internet connection.

### Step 1

Open [barclays.co.uk](https://www.barclays.co.uk) in your web browser and click 'Register' at the top of the page.



## Step 2

You'll see information about who can register for Online Banking. If you're OK to register, scroll down and click 'Start'.

### Register for Online Banking

It should only take a few minutes

You can register if you

- ✔ Live in the **UK**
- ✔ Are **16 or older**
- ✔ Have a Barclays current or savings account with a bank card, or a Barclays mortgage

Accounts that need more than one signature

Your existing Barclays accounts will appear in Online Banking when you register, but accounts that need the signature of more than one person won't be shown.

## Step 6

We'll confirm you're registered for Online Banking and post your passcode to you. It usually arrives within five working days.

Calls to 03 numbers are charged at the same rate as calls to 01 and 02 landlines, and will count towards any inclusive minutes you have covering calls to landline numbers. Charges may apply when calling from abroad.
